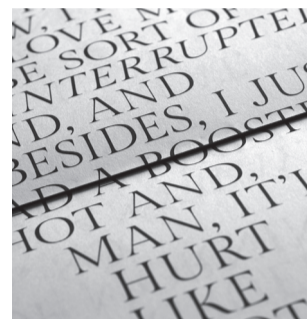

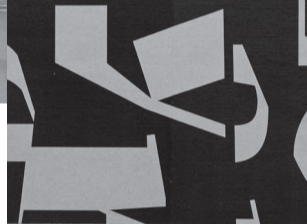
This summer (2022) will be the 8th edition of the Porto Design Summer School. In the previous seven editions we have welcomed 116 participants from 34 countries and from all five continents.



Guest Tutor 2022 – Rejane Dal Bello
An award-winning designer with a history of iconic work, Rejane has 20 years of experience in graphic design and branding, including stints at renowned agencies such as Wolff Olins (UK) and Studio Dumbar (NL). She is author of *Citizen First, Designer Second* (Counterprint, 2020). Based in London, her intentionally small studio works with people from all over the world, pulling in the right expert at the right moment.



The Porto Design Summer School, led by an international team of experienced graphic designers and educators, is about to embark on its 8th edition. We welcome design students at the beginning of their journey and experienced professionals, who are looking to expand their outlooks and take a break from their routines.



We're looking for graduate and post-graduate design students, professional designers, and in general for people who have a passion for making, exploring, testing themselves and sharing with others.



Applications are open and should be made through the Porto Design Summer School website. The deadline for applications is Sunday June 5th.



The course sets out a practical outcome for participants in the form of an individual editorial project that develops personal interests. The aim is to expand technical and conceptual skills and move people closer to finding a unique outlook and signature as a graphic designer.



Hamish Muir completed his design education at the Basel School of Design in 1981 where he studied under Armin Hofmann and Wolfgang Weingart. He was co-founder of *8vo* (1985–2001), a London-based studio which established a considerable international reputation for its typographically-led work. Muir was co-editor of *Octavo*, journal of typography (1986–1992). He is a former lecturer at the London College of Communication. In 2010, he co-founded *MuirMcNeil* in London with Paul McNeil.



Every participant is allocated a single room with private bathroom and each room is equipped with a fridge, stove and microwave oven. The residence is four metro stations (direct) to the centre of the city.

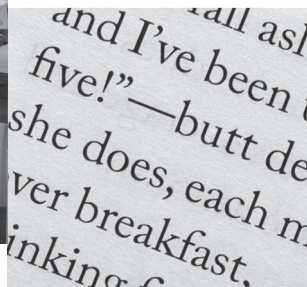


Andrew Howard is a British graphic designer, educator, curator, and design writer. He is founder of *Studio Andrew Howard* that specialises in editorial and exhibition design work for cultural and educational institutions. He is course director of the MA in Communication Design at the Escola Superior de Artes e Design (ESAD) in Porto, where he has lectured for 25 years. He has written for numerous international design publications including *Eye* magazine, *Adbusters*, and the design and cultural criticism website *Design Observer*.



Ronnie Fueglistner is a Swiss graphic designer specialising in book design, typography and type design. He studied at ECAL and at the Basel School of Design where he graduated in 2005, as well as at Zurich University of the Arts where he graduated on Advanced Studies in Type Design in 2013. As specialist in typography and book design he worked together for artists such as Mike Bouchet and Paul McCarthy, Daniel Gustav Cramer, Miriam Cahn, Bruce Nauman, Mandla Reuter, Amy Sillman, Hannah Weinberger and many more.

The course fee for 2022 is 1650 euros and includes tuition, lectures, programme receptions, and accommodation. Airfares and daily meals are not included in the fee. Participants are required to bring a laptop. A fee deposit is required on acceptance to the course.
