2.5. Visa

Our institution will provide guidance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outgoing students/staff, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education. Information and assistance can be provided by International Affairs Office.

2.6. Insurance

Incoming students and staff are **strongly advised** to have valid health insurance coverage for the entire duration of their stay in Türkiye. The insurance should be valid in Türkiye and cover medical treatment, hospitalization, and repatriation costs.

Türkiye has bilateral social security agreements with certain countries. Participants from these countries should check whether their national insurance is valid in Türkiye and whether they are eligible to benefit from it under the agreement.

Those who wish to benefit from the Turkish General Health Insurance system may do so by paying monthly contributions. Necessary guidance and support for this process are provided by the International Affairs Office (UIB).

Alternatively, participants may obtain private health insurance that meets the above requirements.
